The blue polygon indicates the position of the excavated waste body. The numbers given on the map indicate the position at which the photos of this photo sheet were taken on the application site (in order).









**Photos 1, 2 & 3:** These images were taken of the trench excavated on the site. Remnant pieces of waste as well as the regrowth of trees and other vegetation can be seen inside the trench.







**Photos 4 & 5:** This image is taken of the internal road and the local houses that lie just north of the historical waste trench that was excavated on the site. The disturbed condition of the vegetation surrounding the trench can be seen in this image. It can also be clearly observed that the site is dominated by grass and scattered trees.







**Photos 6, 7 & 8:** Several other images were taken of the greater Buisplaas area, i.e., outside of the borders of the WDF considered for surrender in this application, in order to identify and capture other areas of scattered waste surrounding the town.
